

## **Contact Lens Exam Agreement**

## What is a contact lens exam?

A contact lens exam is an additional, separate portion of a comprehensive eye examination. As contact lenses are most often an elective addition to a glasses prescription, most insurance companies do not cover contact lens evaluations. Any contact lens exam fees that are not covered by insurances will be the responsibility of the patient. At Bella Vista Eyecare Associates, our contact lens services range from \$60 to \$170 depending on the type of contact lens being fit. Contact Lens evaluations expire after 1 year.

## What is included in a contact lens exam?

- Determination of candidacy for contact lens wear
- Determination of contact lens prescription based on glasses prescription
- Evaluation of tear film and cornea
- Evaluation of contacts on the eye
- Contact lens trials needed to determine final prescription
- Travel size contact lens solution and case
- Any contact lens related follow-ups for a period of 3 months.

Any contact lens follow-up after 3 months or changes to a finalized prescription will incur a \$60 fee.
